

Annotated Map of the Civil War: Seventh Grade Lesson Plan

Objective: The students will create an annotated map showing the political, economic, and social effects of the Civil War in Texas.

TEKS: 7.5(B)

Materials: Preview handout, Group Check List, Graphically Organized Notes, Texas Map handout, markers

Overview of Activity: Students work in groups of four to complete an annotated map depicting Texas's role in the Civil War.

Preview: Analysis of primary source

Problem Solving Group Work:

- 1. Arrange the classroom and place students in mixed-ability groups of four.
- 2. Introduce the activity. Tell students that each group will complete an annotated map showing Texas's role in the Civil War.
- 3. Review the directions of the check-off sheet. Be sure to emphasize the importance of the graphic organizer.
- 4. Monitor progress as groups create their maps.

Processing: Write a postcard to a friend describing impact of the Civil War on Texas.
